

MEDIATION PROCESS

MN Statute: 518.619

Fees – \$80/hour

Each party will be asked to write out what issues they wish to mediate and the outcomes of the issues they would like to have. This is to make the best most efficient use of the time spent in mediation. The mediator will write a summary of the issues discussed and list the outcomes. The mediator will send the summary to the parties/attorneys.

Once the summary is complete and sent to the parties, it is incumbent on the parties to file it with the court or seek advice from an Attorney as to what the next step for the parties should be.
